WHY GO ON EXCHANGE?

- Cross-cultural perspective on psychology, educational sciences, and adult educational sciences
- Learn a new language
- Be an ambassador for the VUB
- Beneficial for your CV
- · Beneficial if you would like to pursue a career in academia



A WORD OF WARNING

- You will need to do a lot of paperwork / administration
- It might be difficult to get timely reactions from exchange coordinators and professors at the destination
- You may face a great deal of uncertainty
- It may be difficult to set up a learning agreement that perfectly matches your VUB program
- You will need to be flexible
- You will need to take responsibility
- It is possible that you do not obtain a grant
- By default, exchanges for studies are for 1 semester

STUDY EXCHANGE

- For study exchanges, you need to have:
 - Attained 60 ECTS (at the time of application, within current curriculum)
 - Passed 1st Bachelor
- Schakelstudenten / verkorte programma's can also participate (criteria mentioned above do not apply for them)



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

FOR INTERNSHIPS

• The same criteria apply as for regular internships (check with your internship coordinator)



- Some destinations are available for BA or MA students only, others for both
- Warning: it is often easier for psychology students to go abroad in 3rd Bachelor

DESTINATIONS OUTSIDE OF EUROPE

- Available destinations: see list IRMO presentation
- Differences with EU-destinations:
 - More competition for grants
 - No official limit on places available per destination
 - Application procedure is more complicated
 - Host institution may apply their own selection procedures as well



LEARNING AGREEMENT

WHAT IS A LEARNING AGREEMENT (LA)?

- Official document listing the courses you will take at your host university, in exchange for VUB courses
- You select courses worth 21-30 ECTS (for one semester)
- Each selected course in your host university is linked to a VUB course
- There needs to be a balance between the total amount of ECTS on both sides of the learning agreement (max. 2 ECTS difference between both sides – see FAQ at end of slides for more information)
- In case of an imbalance in ECTS between both sides, the ECTS of the host institution count



LEARNING AGREEMENT HOW DO I CREATE A LA?


- Students are responsible for their own LA
- Look at the website of the host institution for information on available courses
- Contact the exchange coordinator at the host institution
- You will create an LA before going to the host institution, but keep in mind that you
 can (and likely will) make changes to you LA during the first weeks of your mobility



LEARNING AGREEMENT

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- STEP 1: Submit a top-3 of destinations + motivation letter
 - Deadline: Friday 6th of December 2024
 - Submission form: https://forms.office.com/e/qCdUykUVS1
- Selection procedure:
 - Exchange coordinators select students for destinations (students who select a non-EU destination will be nominated early to IRMO to speed up process)
 - Criteria: motivation letter + grades (if available) + status student (student with/without fewer opportunities) + participation in mobility in past years
 - All applicants are ranked based on criteria, and allocated to destinations
 - You will receive an email from your exchange coordinator in December/January





APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- STEP 2: Send a first proposal of your LA to your exchange coordinator
 - Deadline: Monday 3rd of February 2025
 - Use the template <u>"Document voorstel Learning Agreement"</u>
 - Add course description of selected courses (in English)
 - You will receive feedback from your exchange coordinator



LEARNING AGREEMENT APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- STEP 3: Send a revised learning agreement to your exchange coordinator
 - Deadline: Monday 3rd of March 2025
 - Exchange coordinator will decide if your revised LA can be approved
 - If your LA is approved, the exchange coordinator will officially nominate you for an exchange with IRMO
 - IRMO will contact you, to guide you through the rest of the application procedure



LEARNING AGREEMENT

APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR INTERNSHIPS

- STEP 1: Contact your internship coordinator
 - You can suggest a destination of your own choosing
 - Get approval from internship coordinator on destination and internship plan
- STEP 2: Contact your exchange coordinator
 - Deadline: Monday 3rd of March 2025
 - Inform exchange coordinator of destination, so we can nominate you with IRMO

BUDDY PROGRAMME

FAQ

- My LA is already officially approved, but I want to make changes. What do I need to do?
 - Contact your exchange coordinator. Send a proposal for a changed LA using the template "Document voorstel Learning Agreement". You can enter changes in mobility online during first week of exchange.
- I changed my mind and I want to stop my exchange
 - Inform your exchange coordinator, IRMO, and the host institution
- Do I need to register the VUB courses in my LA in self-service?
 - No, the faculty administration will do this for you
- Can I select a language course in my LA?
 - Yes, in exchange for a VUB keuzevak and provided that the language course is taught at the host institution



FAQ

- I must redo exams at the VUB in August-September, can I still go on exchange?
 - You will have to wait until the official proclamation of the exams in the beginning of September before you can leave on exchange. You will be allowed to go on exchange if you meet the eligibility criteria and if you did not get an "Inschrijving niet toegelaten" following the exams
- I failed an exam at the host institution, what now?
 - Try and redo the exam at the host institution. If this is not possible, redo the VUB course in the second exam period. If this does not happen, redo the VUB course next academic year.
- I exchanged 2 courses at the host institution for 1 VUB course, but I failed 1 of the 2 courses at the host institution. What now?
 - Try and redo the exam at the host institution. If this is not possible, redo the VUB course in the second exam period. If this does not happen, redo the VUB course next academic year.
- I want to leave in the first week of February, but I still have an exam at the VUB.
 - You can ask the dean of the faculty to allow you to do the exam on a different day (see Onderwijs- en examenreglement)



FAQ

- Are differences in ECTS allowed between VUB courses and courses at the host institution in the learning agreement?
 - Yes, differences are allowed. However, we do check the difference between the total amount of ECTS for VUB courses in the LA and the total amount of ECTS for host institution courses. This difference should not be larger than 2 ECTS. The exception to this is that students can take more credits at the host institution, but these extra credits will not be recognized at the VUB then. For example:
 - 19 ECTS at VUB 21 ECTS at host institution = ok
 - 21 ECTS at VUB 19 ECTS at host institution. = ok
 - 21 ECTS at VUB 18 ECTS at host institution = not ok
 - 18 ECTS at VUB 21 ECTS at host institution = ok
