

Green Travel

Definition

Green travel is the travel that uses low-emissions means of transport for **the main part** of the travel, such as bus, train or car-pooling to travel to/travel from my Erasmus mobility destination.



What is considered as a valid Green Travel?

- Travel by bus, train or car-pooling (e.g. Flixbus, BlaBlaCar,...etc.). You'll need to upload your tickets to proof it.
- If you travel with e.g. a classmate that also goes to the same exchange destination by using the same transport (e.g. a car), you'll need to sign a Declaration of Honour to proof it.
- Your proof needs to show your Green Travel from Belgium until your exchange destination and from your exchange destination until Belgium.



What is **not** considered as a valid Green Travel?

- If you travel with your family to your destination by car. This is not considered as car-pooling.
- If you use an electrical car to reach or come back from your destination
- If you use the Green Travel option only to reach your destination but not to travel back to Belgium
- If you use the Green Travel option only to travel back to Belgium but not to reach your destination
